AIMS OF EDUCATION

The intention of the school is to awaken the intelligence of the child and let him/her flower in goodness. The cultivation of a global outlook in an atmosphere of freedom and responsibility, a spirit of enquiry without bias and a concern for man and environment are integral to the scheme of education. Some of the important features of the educational philosophy of the school are:

1. To holistically educate a child so that he/she becomes a positive contributing factor to the society.
2. To inculcate a love for nature and respect for all forms of life.
3. To create an atmosphere of Love, Order & Freedom without either fear or prejudice.
4. Not to condition the child strongly in any particular belief, either religious, political or social, so that his/her mind may be free to ask fundamental questions, inquire and learn.
5. To teach without the motive of a reward, punishment or comparison.

Knowledge, like life, is a cycle. It stands with a question for which you seek an answer. Next comes understanding – the answer and analyzing it, which then leads to necessary action or application. This in turn leads to another question and the cycle thus goes on and grows on. At RVN, a child's freedom and space is respected to enable him to bloom into a well groomed individual who can observe and assimilate knowledge through a process of self-discovery. The endeavour is to keep this flame of inquiry burning in the child.

The purpose, the aim and drive of the school, is to create the right climate and environment so that the child may develop fully as a complete human being. Equipped with technological proficiency so that he/she may function with clarity and efficiency in the modern world and having the vision, wisdom and the opportunity to flower in goodness, so that he or she is rightly related to people, things and ideas, to the whole of life.

Based on this philosophy, we at RVN attempt to create an atmosphere of space, freedom, care and security in which students are helped to enlarge their horizons and grow.

The school is concerned with developing the individual talent and intelligence of each student. We feel it is important for parents to be equally aware of their child's talents as well as limitations and allow of him/her to develop in his/her own way and not on the basis of predetermined expectation.



ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Established in 2011 the school is a self contained unit under the aegis of 'The Rabisons Foundaiton' a trust pursuing activities related to the development of the society at large. It is situated at Badahal, approximately 1.5K.M. from the centre of Keonjhar Town by the side of N.H -49. The school campus has a sprawling area of about 10acres and the surroundings are picturesque with an ideal atmosphere for learning.

The school is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi.



THE ACADEMIC YEAR

The academic session starts form March/April and terminates in February/March of every year. It is divided into two terms:

- First Term : March to September/October
- Second Term : October/November to February

The exact dates of reopening and closing of the school including other holidays will be made available to the parents.





CURRICULUM

RVN is a co-educational, Senior Secondary School from Grade I, following the syllabus laid down by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi. The school offers Science & Commerce stream in the Senior Secondary Level. The medium of instruction is English. In keeping up with the educational philosophy- personal attention is given to the total care and development of the child. There are facilities for art, craft, music, dance, yoga, singing and various forms of games, physical exercises and swimming.

- The strength of the students in each class doesn't exceed 40.
- Teacher – Student ratio is meaningfully kept low to ensure personal attention. Teacher- Student Ratio is 1:15.
- Faculty members are highly qualified, richly experienced and fully dedicated.
- In order to promote latent talent and creativity, periods are allotted in the time table for Arts/Craft and Music up to the secondary level.
- As a part of the overall development of personality, students are encouraged to participate in different school programmes which include quiz, debates, elocution, symposiums, thematic discussions, extempore speech and cultural programmes.
- The school has a modern, well equipped multimedia computer laboratory with the latest hardware/software.
- The school has modern well-equipped Science laboratories which are extensively used to enhance theoretical knowledge.
- A separate library building, stocked with books of varied theme & flavour ranging from classes to contemporary, caters for the academic requirements as well as leisure reading. The library receives a number of news papers, a wide variety of journals, periodicals and magazines to keep the students well informed about the current happenings in India and Abroad.

Value Education:

RVN is unique school where value education is imparted in letter and spirit. Value education enables children to understand the need to learn virtues and values and develop their character accordingly.

Evaluation:

Learning & evaluation go hand in hand. At RVN continuous and comprehensive evaluation is part of the learning process. Grades awarded for unit tests, assignments, project works, seminars and symposiums are included proportionately towards the total annual grade. Records are maintained of the students' progress throughout the year and are sent to the parents at the end of each term.

Communication Skills

Communication plays a major role in the modern world. All education is futile without the development of proper communication skills. Few methods adopted at RVN for the development of communication such as:

- Exposure to oral comprehension and expression using audio cds.
- Elocution, debates and group discussion to foster verbal communication.
- Essay writing and story writing programmes are help to improve written expression.
- Extempore speeches and other related activities in the assembly and active participation in dramatics play a key role in the development of communication skills.

Environmental Awareness:

Environmental awareness programmes are an integral part of the RVN system of education whereby the students are encouraged to promote environmental awareness by drawing pictures, poems, eassys, stories, slogans and case studies that relate to the local situation.



Health Care:

The RVN appropriate medical facilities will be provided to cater to the healthcare needs of the students.

There will be regular medical examination of the students and their medical records maintained.

Sports/Games:

Sports and games are an important part of the student's life. These have been given adequate stress and included in the school routine to promote good health, self confidence, team spirit, besides providing them the needed recreation. A wide choice of excellent sporting facilities is available in a multipurpose hall with an area of 17,000 sq. Ft. The hall has facilities for Badminton, a Basket Ball & Table Tennis. It also has a 400 sq. Ft. LED Screen & performance stage. Swimming Pool facility is provided in the school campus to both Junior & Senior Children.

Clubs & Societies:

As a part of the overall personality development programme students are encouraged to participate in various hobbies and activities viz martial arts, electronics, vocal/instrumental music, fine arts, dance, clay modelling, painting gardening,

photography, wall magazines, quix, dramatics, elocution and literary clubs. There are around – hobby clubs, where resource persons from outside come to equip the children with skills that might help the children to start imagining about their future professions.

Social Service Programmes:

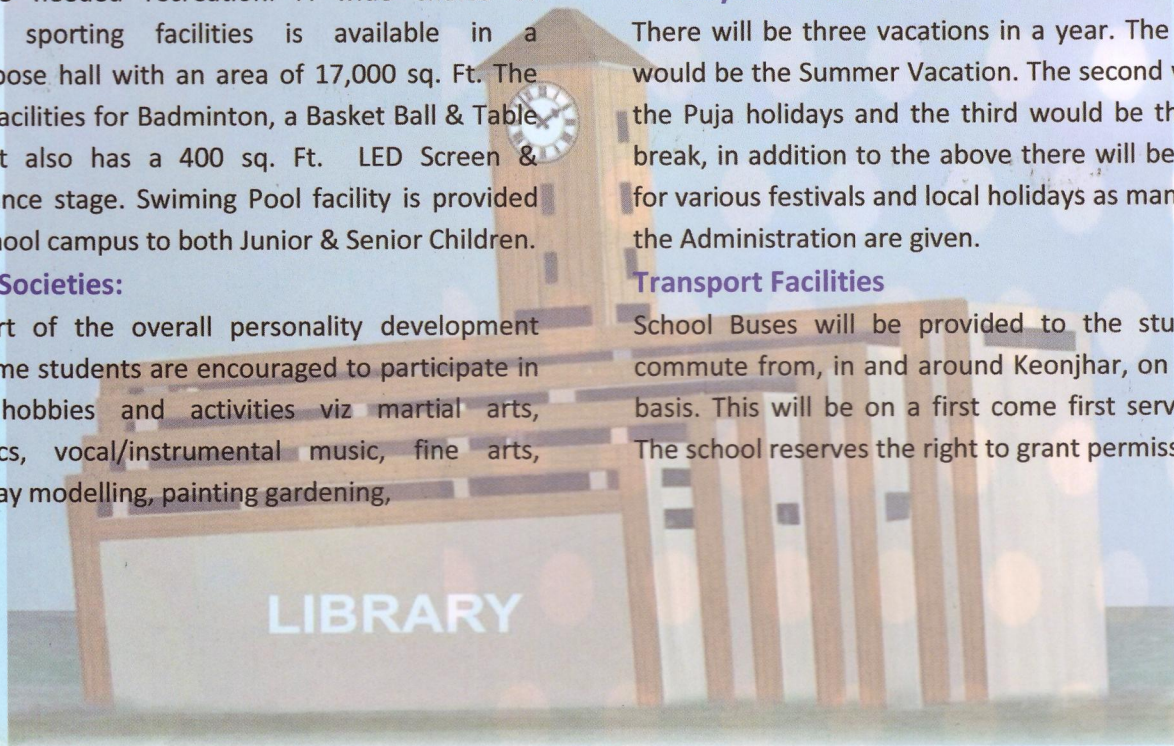
Various Social Scheme Programmes are organized by the school to inculcate the value of dignity of labour and compassion towards the downtrodden segment of society.
